



The Noble County Youth Soccer would like to extend a great gratitude to the MarkWest Seneca Plant and The Safety Group (of Derwent Ohio) for the recent donation of an Automated External Defibrillator (AED)

The Noble County Youth Soccer League is a non-profit community organization that strives to provide a safe, fun, and educational soccer experience for the youth of Noble County Ohio. The organization was formed in the late 90's and continues to grow each year. This year we currently have 180 kids that range from age 4 to age 12. On game day Sunday, we will average 500 and 600 people attending the soccer facility.

In 2017, the State of Ohio required all sports-related organization to educate their coaches, parents, and players on the Lindsey Law (sudden cardiac arrest). AED is a portable device that checks the heart rhythm and can send an electric shock to the heart to restore a normal rhythm. Last year there were 356,000 sudden cardiac arrests events in the United States, without the use of an AED 90% were fatal. With this donation, the Noble County Youth Soccer now has a life-saving tool in case of a sudden cardiac arrest event.
